EDGAR FILINGS OF FORM 13F

On January 12, 1999, the Securities and Exchange Commission (the SEC) adopted a new rule requiring institutional investment managers to file reports on Form 13F with the SEC via EDGAR, the SEC's electronic filing system. Institutional investment managers with investment discretion over \$100 million dollars or more in equity securities traded on securities exchanges or Nasdaq are required to file quarterly

reports with the SEC on Rule 13F within 45 days of the end of each calendar quarter, commencing with the last quarter of the calendar year in which such investment manager initially had discretion over at least \$100 million of such equity securities. [Institutional investment managers are generally defined as any person other than a natural person investing in or buying and selling securities for its own account, and any person exercising investment discretion with respect to the account of any other person.]
