

Various federal health programs and authorities set to expire at the end of the fiscal year under current law:

| Expiring Program/Authority | Program Details | Expiration Dates Under Current Law |

| | Medicare | |
| Medicare Dependent Hospital Program | Provides enhanced payments to hospitals that have 100 or fewer beds, operate in a rural area, are not a Sole Community Hospital and have at least 60% of its inpatient days or discharges covered by Medicare | October 1, 2025 |
| Medicare Add on Payment for Ambulance Services | Temporary add-on payments that increase Medicare reimbursements for ground ambulance services (3% increase for rural origins, 2% increase for urban origins and 22.6% increase for super-rural origins) | October 1, 2025 |
| Medicare Quality Measures | Provides CMS funding to develop and update quality of care measures for value-based payment programs and quality reporting under the Medicare program | September 30, 2025 |
| Medicare Extension of State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP) Funding | Funding supports a community-based network of state and local programs that provide personalized assistance to Medicare beneficiaries and their families to understand Medicare benefits and enrollment choices | September 30, 2025 |
| Medicare Geographic Practice Cost Index (GPCI) | Adjusts payments to physicians under the Medicare Physician Fee Schedule based on the geographic area where they practice | October 1, 2025 |
| Acute Hospital Care at Home Waiver Authority | Allows hospitals to provide inpatient-level care in Medicare patients' homes, requiring a CMS-approved hospital to apply for and receive a waiver from specific Conditions of Participation (COPs) | September 30, 2025 |
| Medicare Telehealth Flexibility | Temporary flexibilities in Medicare's telehealth coverage that were implemented during the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency | September 30, 2025 |
| Medicare Low-Volume Hospitals (LHV) Program | Provides add-on payments to certain hospitals with low discharge volumes and locations more than 25 miles from another IPPS (Inpatient Prospective Payment System) hospital | September 30, 2025 |

| Delay Medicaid Disproportionate Share Hospital (DSH) Payment Reductions | Provides a delay in cuts to payments to hospitals serving a large number of uninsured and Medicaid patients to cover uncompensated care costs | September 30, 2025 |
| | Public Health | |
| Teaching Health Center Graduate Medical Education | Payments to outpatient settings to fund a portion of their costs for training physicians and dentists in approved residency programs with a focus on rural and underserved areas | September 30, 2025 |
| Special Diabetes Programs | Provides funding for type 1 diabetes research and type 2 diabetes prevention programs for American Indians and Alaska Natives | September 30, 2025 |
| National Health Security Programs and Authorities | Programs and authorities related to preventing, detecting, preparing for and responding to public health emergencies, such as infectious disease outbreaks, whether natural, accidental or intentional | September 30, 2025 |
| Community Health Centers, Health Center Program | Funding for Community Health Centers through the Health Center Program. Current funding consists of a combination of discretionary and mandatory funding from the Community Health Center Fund (CHCF) | September 30, 2025 |
| National Health Service Corp | Provides scholarships and loan repayments to health care providers in exchange for a period of service in a health professional shortage area (HPSA) | September 30, 2025 |
