Economic Measures	Commercial Bank of Dubai has opened up its shares to foreign investment. The bank has set a foreign ownership limit at 40 percent. (Link)
Health & Safety	 On June 14, the UAE saw 304 new cases (-38.08% from the previous day) of the coronavirus, bringing the total to 42,294 total confirmed cases. (Link) World Security, the security solutions provider for DP World has unveiled a new smart helmet that is designed to make contactless detection of people potentially infected with the coronavirus. (Link) The UAE Volunteers campaign started a training program for volunteers to support health emergency response teams and nursing staff. The training will provide volunteers with nursing skills to enable them to support experts in the field. (Link) The Abu Dhabi Health Services Company (SEHA) obtained 402 blood plasma units from donors who recovered from the coronavirus and used that plasma to treat 247 infected patients. (Link)
Travel	 The UAE has launched a campaign to bring 200,000 residents stranded abroad back to the UAE. (Link) Flydubai extends its salary cuts and puts pilots on unpaid leave to alleviate the financial burdens imposed by the coronavirus.
