

Validity of State Department Export Authorizations

State Authorization	Validity
ITAR Agreements — all items transitioning to CCL	Two years from effective date of revised USML category (i.e., for Category VIII and Category XIX, October 15, 2015) or date of expiration, whichever comes first, unless revoked, suspended or terminated.
ITAR Agreements — some items transitioning to CCL	Two years from effective date of revised USML category (i.e., for Category VIII and Category XIX, October 15, 2015) or date of expiration, whichever comes first, unless revoked, suspended or terminated. To remain valid beyond two years after the effective date of the revised USML category, they must be amended to authorize the CCL items using the new (x) paragraph.
DSP-5 Licenses — all items transitioning to CCL	Two years from effective date of revised USML category (i.e., for Category VIII and Category XIX, October 15, 2015), until returned by license holder, or expired, whichever comes first, unless revoked, suspended or terminated.
DSP-5 Licenses — some items transitioning to CCL	Until expired or returned by license holder, unless otherwise revoked, suspended or terminated.
DSP-61 and DSP-73 Licenses	Valid until expired or returned by the license holder, unless otherwise revoked, suspended or terminated.
